This shuttle provides transportation between the PATH station in Harrison and bus stops along Ridge Road and Kearny Avenue up to Garden Terrace in North Arlington. The shuttle is funded in part by New

Transit Workers Eligible for COVID Vaccination – March 15th



The Centers for Disease Control has further defined the essential workers' category, breaking it down into specific industries and placing transportation workers and others in Phase 1B of COVID-19 deployment. In New Jersey, as of March 15th, Transportation Workers, including the following are eligible:

- · Bus, taxi, rideshare, and airport employees.
- · NJ TRANSIT workers.
- Motor Vehicle Commission staff.
