During this challenging time, EZ Ride, in conjunction with The Alliance for a Healthier Asbury Park, uses their NJHI grant money to assist all Asbury Park residents in getting to doctor's appointments and going food shopping. The Ryde4Life program launched by EZ Ride uses the transportation services offered by Lyft and Uber and was designed to serve older adults to address their transportation challenges.
