### **Pedestrian Safety Tips**

**Be Seen**

1. Wear bright colours
2. Wear reflectors
3. Carry flashlights
4. Walk facing traffic

**Be Smart**

1. Watch for drivers turning at intersections
2. Always cross at designated crosswalks
3. Never cross once the signal has turned yellow or red
4. Make eye contact with drivers
5. Remove headphones
6. Stay off your phone

**Be Safe**  
Stop, look, listen.

4. Collect small figurines and toys you have at home you wish to use (lego people, dolls, hot wheels cars, trucks, school buses, bikes, trees, RR tracks, etc)
5. Find something to use as your base that will fit your toys (lego base, shoebox, flat piece of cardboard, etc)
6. Paint or draw roads, sidewalks, bike lanes. You can also use paper cut outs to make roads, crosswalks, and sidewalks that can be moved around.
7. Make and add small trees, houses, shrubs and small safety signs (Stop, Ped. Crossing, School Zone, 25 mph Speed Limit)
8. Enjoy playing with your homemade walking or biking safety diorama
