Every year EZ Ride's Bike and Pedestrian team partners with more than 200 different communities and organizations-including schools, traffic police, health and recreation departments, complete streets and pedestrian safety groups, environmental commissions and green teams, community and senior centers, mayor's wellness groups, libraries, bike clubs/shops, and non-profits.

What makes us different?

- Service is Free Our services are offered at no cost to you, thanks to grants from government agencies and private foundations.
- Focus on Youth We work with various community stakeholders to provide safety information, bike skills, poster contests and even distribute free bicycles and bike helmets.
- Equity is important to us and disadvantaged communities are a priority.

What do we offer?

- √ Safety Presentations: Conduct walking, biking, e-bike/e-scooter, and driving safety presentations for all ages.
- ✓ Walk & Bike Audits: Assist with walk and bike audits and help prepare school travel plan reports for infrastructure grant applications.
- ✓ Demonstration Projects: Plan and implement demonstration projects to test safer roadway redesigns.
- ✓ Policy Support: Assist communities to adopt Complete Streets, Safe Routes to School (SRTS) District, and Crossing Guard policies.
- ✓ Speed Studies: Conduct speed monitoring studies and provide recommendations to calm traffic.
- ✓ Public Safety Outreach and Education: Support safety education and enforcement campaigns.

- ✓ Volunteer Training: Provide training for adult volunteers to lead walking and biking buses for students traveling to school.
- ✓ Bike Lockers: Manage bike lockers at five NJ TRANSIT train stations— Westfield, Rahway, Cranford, Roselle Park, and Maplewood—in partnership with NJ TRANSIT.
- ✓ Grant Assistance: Assist communities in applying for grants supporting active transportation
- ✓ Safe Routes to School Awards: Help schools and municipalities earn recognition awards for their commitment and support of safe walking and biking.
